Key Points

Feed recommendations

Introduce to calves from one day of age as a supplement to milk. Increase the amount fed gradually up to weaning. Typically, calves can be weaned from milk when consuming 1kg Rumatain Calf 17% per head per day for 3 consecutive days. Continue to offer pellets to calves post-weaning to help maintain growth during the transition to an all-grass diet.

Always give calves access to clean drinking water and roughage such as quality hay or straw.
